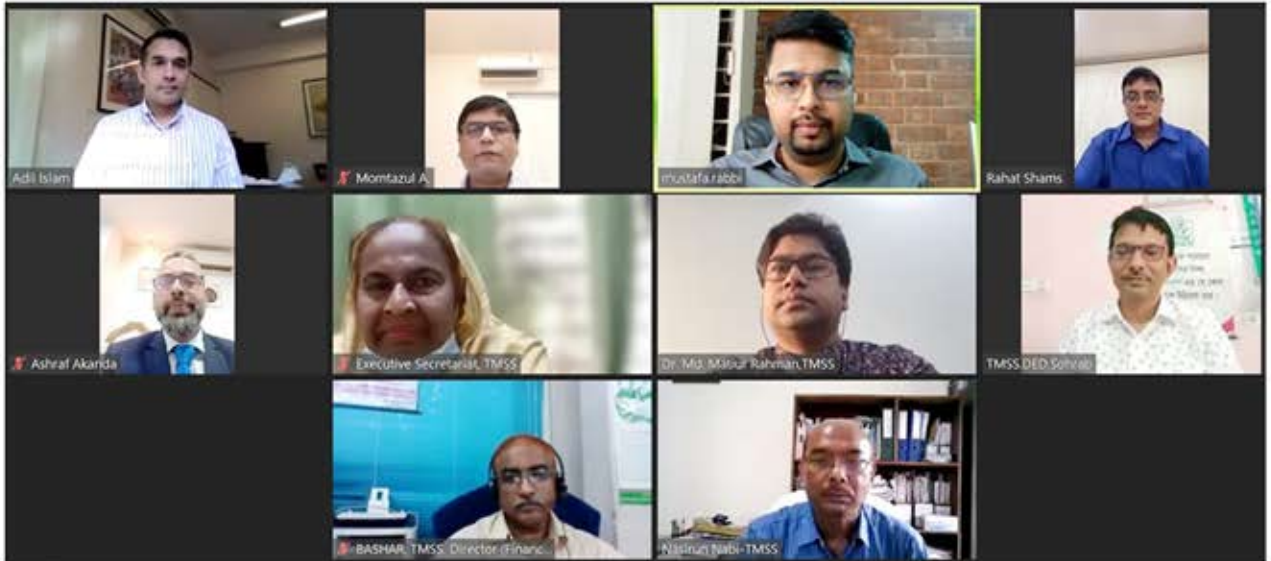


Bank Alfalah Collaborates with TMSS for CSR Activities



To aid low income people in facing COVID 19 crisis, Bank Alfalah has recently donated the amount equivalent to 1% of its net profit from 2020. This donation will be used to provide necessity item relief packs containing food items and health protection supplies. 50% of the relief packs will be distributed in city corporation areas and the remaining 50% will be distributed in district/upazila areas of Rajshahi and Khulna.

For this project, we have collaborated with Thengamara Mohila Sabuj Sangha (TMSS), one of the top NGOs of the country and our valued client. TMSS has been working towards providing underprivileged women a better life with dignity in the family and society through their capacity building, adaptability, responsiveness, optimum use of their own/available resource, participation in development activities, good governance, establishment of their legitimate rights on a sustainable footing since 1980. Their large network both in urban and rural areas make TMSS the perfect choice to undertake this project with.

A total of **1,730 people** (865 in City Corporation areas and 865 in district level areas) will receive the relief packs under this project.

The collaboration was finalized in a meeting attended by Senior members of both the organizations including our Hon'ble Country Head and Executive Director of TMSS.

Bank Alfalah remains committed to provide further support as much as possible to the poor and needy and is closely monitoring the situation in this regard.
